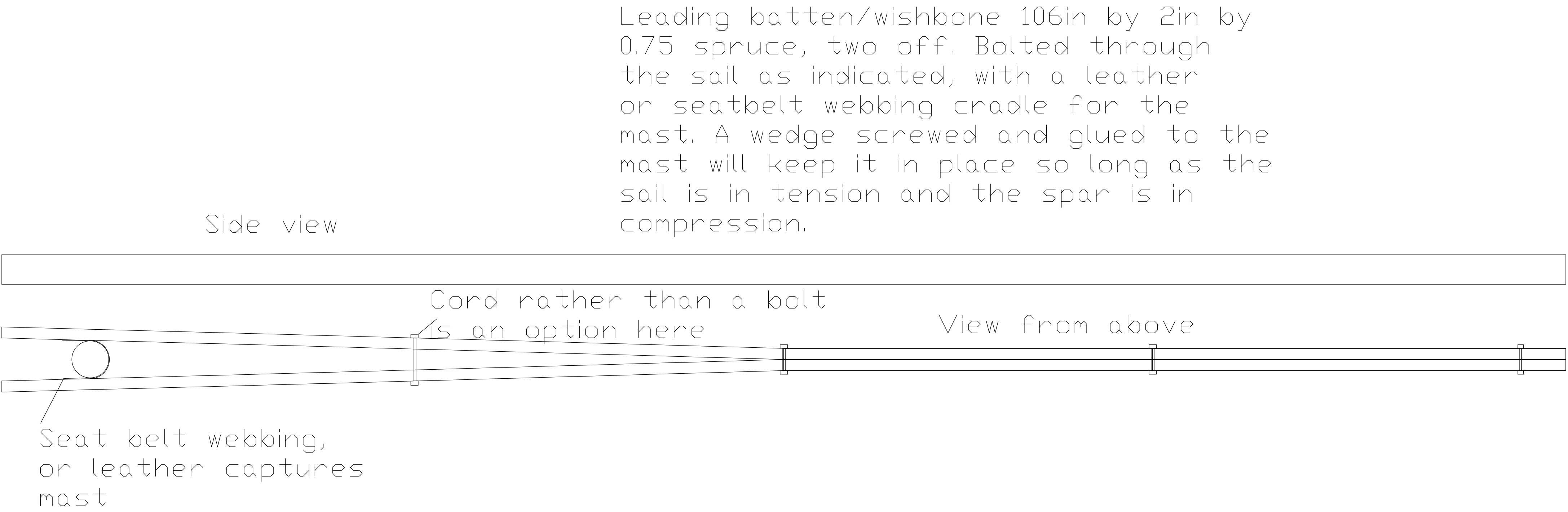
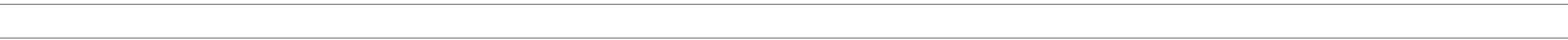


Mast: 2.5 by 2.5 by 162 inches, square at bottom for first 11 to 12 inches, then six-sided and rounded. Top third may be tapered to 1.5in diameter.

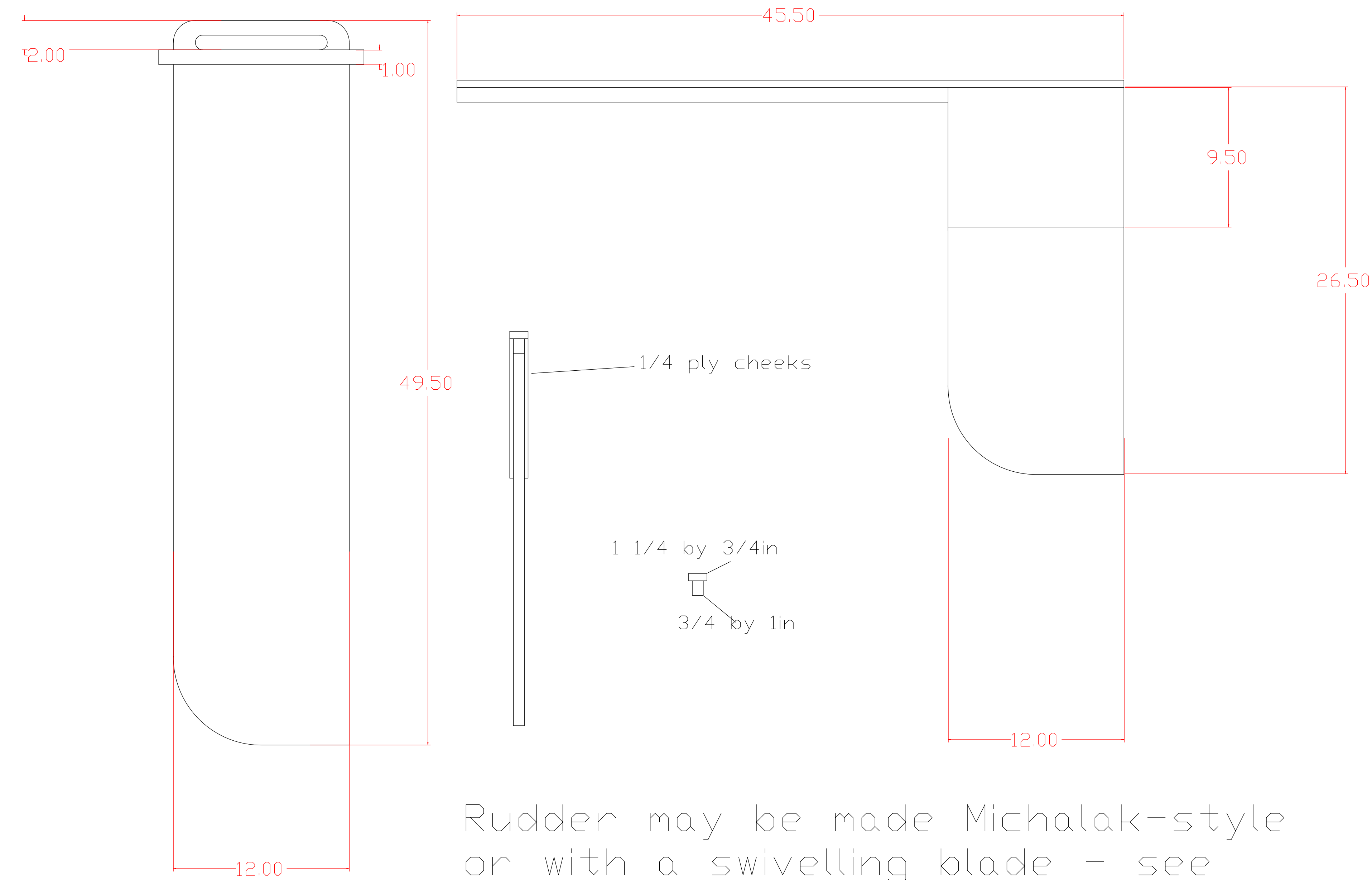


Batten



Battens are 92in long and sized to fit in 2in wide pockets. They may be made from a variety of materials: Reuel Parker is said to favour polythene plumber's piping flattened in hot water at one end and reinforced by wooden dowelling at the other. 3/8in ply might be good, particularly if doubled or even trebled over the aftmost third or half of the batten length (whatever curve there is should be at the mast end). They should be tied into the pockets to prevent loss.

Foils, spars etc. Mast dimensions increase in length to accommodate larger rigs.
